Instruction for Use	
Surface Preparation	Concrete floors should be fully cured, structurally sound, clean, dry, and free of surface contaminates and dust for Eg.
	Concrete must accept water penetration. Test by lightly sprinkling water on various areas of the substrate. If water penetrates, then a good bond with a selected primer can be achieved. If water beads and fails to be absorbed by the concrete surface contaminants are present then loss of adhesion may occur.
	Contaminates that are present should be mechanically removed before insulation.
	All Substrates should be moisture tested prior to the application of Sikafloor levelling systems and be within the parameters of AS 1884 – 2012.
	If moisture content is higher than 5% by Sika tramex or 75% RH the application of SikaTite Moisture Seal 1k to the affected areas is recommended. See most current PDS for further information.
	Ambient temperature, surfaces and materials should be maintained at temperatures higher than 10°C. Concrete must be free of efflorescence and not subject to hydrostatic pressure.
Priming	Internal Porous Priming:
	> Sikafloor 01 Primer - diluted up to 1:3 with clean water
	> Sikafloor Level PRO Primer - undiluted
	Internal Non-porous Priming:
	> Sikafloor 01 Primer - undiluted
	Internal Moisture Barrier & Primer:
	> Sikatite Mositure Seal 1K - undiluted
	Primer should be allowed to dry as recommended for the specific primer prior to the application of Sikafloor levelling systems.
	On particularly porous surfaces a mix ratio of Sikafloor 01 Primer 1:2 or 1:1 with
	clean water is recommended.
	Refer to the latest PDS for the relevant primer prior to application.
Mixing	Mix the entire 20kg bag of powder with 5.2 - 5.4 litres of clean, cool water. When applying as a neat product above 20mm Sika recommends 5.2L be added. Slowly add powder to the water while mixing with a heavy duty 13mm electric drill and mixing paddle at 500rpm. Thoroughly mix for 2 minutes to a lump-free consistency.
Application Instructions	
Application	Pour or pump Sikafloor Level PRO, then spread with a long handled gauged spreader to heights as required.
	For self-levelling up to 75mm add 10kg of clean 2 – 5mm aggregates per 20kg of Sikafloor Level PRO. This mix ratio will approximately equal 16.5L of product.
	Sikafloor Level PRO can be extended up to 1:1 with Sikadur 505 silica sand for use as a spot repair and ramping mortar.
Coverage	20kg bag of Sikafloor Level PRO mixed with $5.2 - 5.4L$ of water will cover approximately $4m^2$ at 3mm thick, or equal 12L of product.
Drying	After final set Sikafloor Level PRO dries to a walkable hardness in approximately 12-14 hours at 21°C. Allow 24 hours at 21°C prior to the application of impervious floor coverings and wood flooring. All times are dependent on thickness of Sikafloor Level PRO, temperature, air flow & relative humidity. Testing for moisture content before applying floorcoverings is recommended.

Cleaning	Clean tools and equipment with warm water and detergent while the product is still wet.
Notes on Application / Limitations	Do not use Sikafloor Level PRO over lightweight concrete, particleboard, hardwood floors, parquet floors or metal.
	Do not mix or apply Sikafloor Level PRO in temperatures below 10°C and above 35°C and under hot and windy conditions.
	Not recommended as a trafficable surface
	Do not use on sloped surfaces that require drainage
	Do not use in exterior applications
